# WHAT'S THE CAMPAIGN ABOUT?

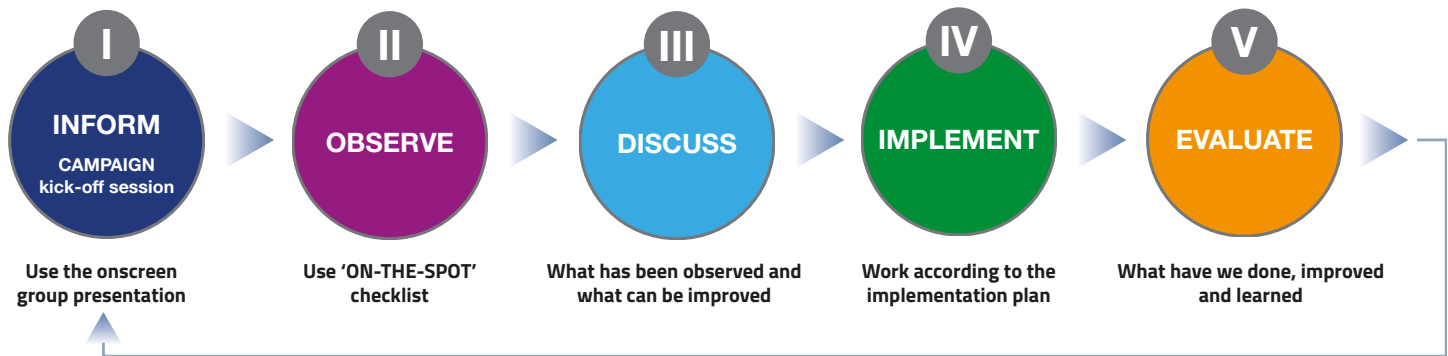

**5 to remember**

- 1 Discuss the tasks and risks beforehand. If in doubt, do not start work!
- 2 Use the gloves prescribed for the job in question.
- 3 Do not remove any protective covers, barriers or safety devices of the machines.
- 4 Avoid injuries by working hands-free as much as possible. Keep your hands out of the danger zone.
- 5 Take off all rings and jewelry during work.
